### Possessives: 'S

Le agregamos 's a sustantivos en singular para demostrar posesión.

Examples:

*We are having a party at John's house.*

*Michael drove his friend's car.*

Le agregamos ' a sustantivos en plural que terminen en -s:

Examples:

*This is my parents' house.*

*Those are ladies' shoes.*

Pero utilizamos 's con sustantivos irregulares plurales.

Examples:

men	women	children	people
-----	-------	----------	--------

*These are men's shoes.*

*Children's clothes are very expensive.*

Podemos utilizar el posesivo en vez de una palabra para evitar repetir.

Examples:

*Is that John's car?*

*No, it's Mary's. (NOT No, it's Mary's [ear].)*

*Whose coat is this?*

*It's my wife's. (NOT It's my wife's [eət].)*
